Welcome

Thank you for requesting information about our society. We meet for lectures at the Princess Pavilion Falmouth on Fridays from 10.00am, once a month, apart from July and August, with the lecture beginning at 10.30am. Coffee is available before the lecture from 9.45 am onwards.

We have a programme of 10 Lectures a year plus a number of Study Days and Visits to places of interest. The lectures at the Pavilion are in a ground floor conference room, with comfortable seating arranged for members and guests. Facilities include raised seating together with a loop induction system for those with hearing difficulties.

New Member Fees

As a new member you are required to pay a £10 Registration Fee and a pro-rata Membership Fee. Full membership for the year of 10 lectures is £41. The table below shows the New Member Fee due, depending upon your date of joining. For example if you were to join on the 14th November 2011, the New Member Fee would be £38.70 (£10 Registration + 7 remaining lectures @ £4.10 each).

On your payment of the New Member Fee we will send you a synopsis of the lecture subjects, a Programme Card with lecture dates, together with additional information about study days and visits. (Please note additional charges apply for Study Days and Visits.)
